A typical day on board

Wake up and swim or a morning run or walk

Everyone has their own berth on board, though nothing beats sleeping on deck under the stars! Feel free to make yourself a coffee while the rest is still asleep. Wake up early and take the time to further explore the island and stretch our legs.

8:00 Breakfast Buffet by the crew

Grab whatever you want, including something freshly prepared by the crew.

9:30- 10am Departure

We all pitch in to prepare the boat for departure. After we lift anchor everyone is free to help sailing, or not if you just want to sunbathe and read a book that's no problem. You can take part in as much or as little sailing as you wish.

Afternoon Swim & Lunch stop in a remote bay

While the crew prepares a delicious lunch, there's plenty of time to go for a swim. Maybe all the way to the island we're anchored close to and go on a scavenger hunt there?

After lunch we depart for our evening destination

The question of the day is will we see dolphins or turtles today? Amazing when Flipper swims along with the boat.

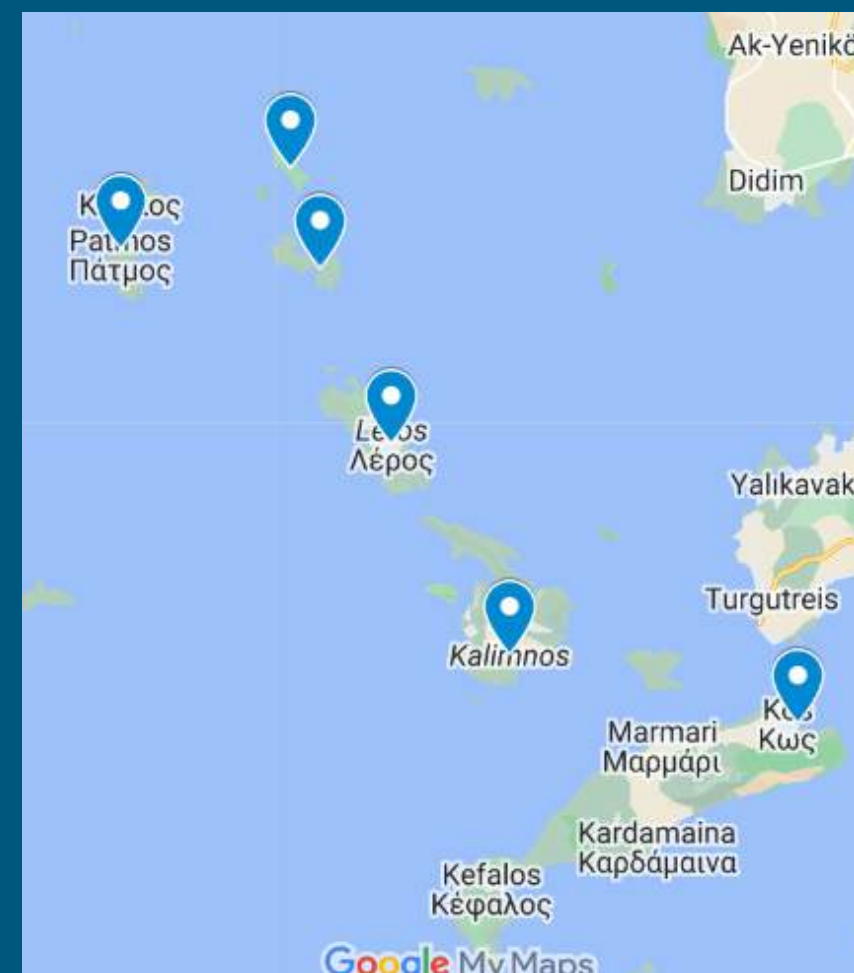
Explore the island before dinner

We dock in port on a cute little island if we don't go for anchor in a remote bay for the night. Later in the evening we all go out for a food fest in a small local taverna, and until then everyone is free to explore the island.

7-Day Northern Route

Departing and returning from Kos, along Kalimnos, Lipsi, Patmos, Arkoi, and Leros.



12-Day Northern Route

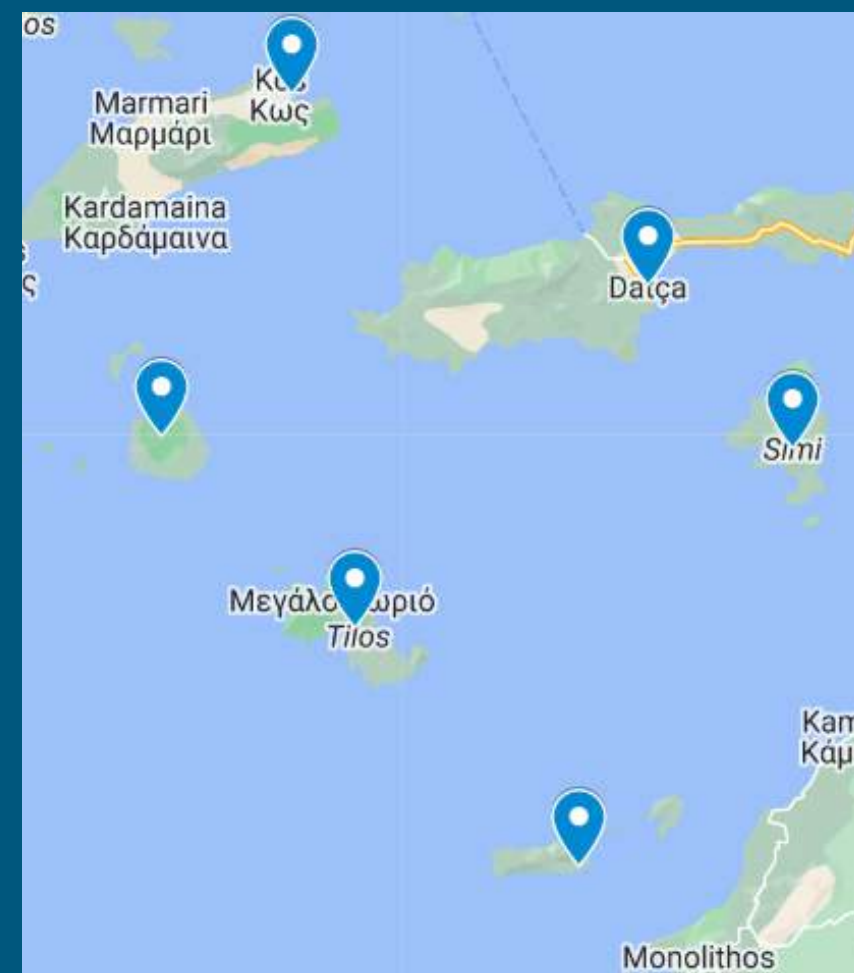

Our Itineraries - Southern Dodecanese

7-Day Southern Route

Including a little part of Turkey, departing and returning from Kos, along Nisyros, Tilos, Chalki, Simi, and Datca.



12-Day Southern Route

Including a little part of Turkey, departing and returning from Kos, along Datca, Simi, Bozuk Buku, Rhodes, Chalki, Tilos, Nisyros and Knidos.



Shareboat sailing holidays

So, how do our shareboat charters work?

Any solo traveller, friends travelling together or couples book a sailing holiday with us and hop on board with other fellow travellers (max 8 per trip). They join a planned charter along one of our itineraries, without the hassle of having to arrange anything themselves.

Prices

€ 1395 low season / € 1595 high season per person in a shared cabin (7 day trips)

€ 2195 low season / € 2495 high season per person in a shared cabin (12 day trips)

Low Season – May and October | High Season – June, July, August and September

We don't like the "extra" charges, we include in your charter fee: skipper, hostess, breakfast and lunches on board, complimentary happy hour beer and wine on the first night, soft drinks for the duration of the charter, fuel, and marina fees. There are no hidden charges or surprises.

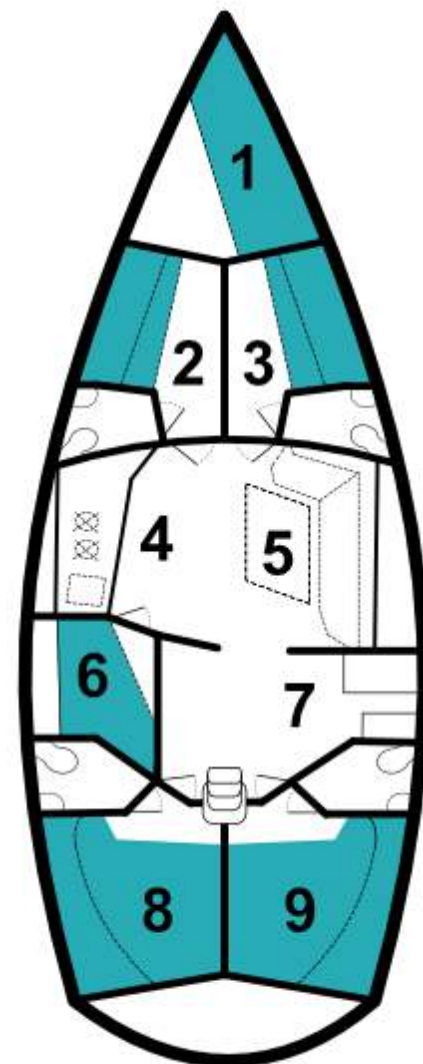
Not included: transportation to/from the boat, dinners on shore, alcoholic drinks after happy hour (bring your own!), personal travel insurance.



Our Yacht

Artemis is a modern-designed 55' sloop, with a semi-pilothouse design which creates a very unusual – and huge! – split-level saloon. The lower level is the main dining area and galley, with tons of seating and cooking space. Artemis accommodates 8 guests and 2 crew members.
