NOTICE OF RACE

1 THE EVENT

Clifden regatta will take place on Friday 6th, Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th of August 2010. It is intention of the organising committee to run 2 classes both racing under IRC and ECHO, the class division will depend on entries. Skippers briefing will be held at 13.00hrs on Friday 6th August.

2 RULES

The event will be sailed under the racing rules of sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association (ISA), the IR2000 (IRC) rating rule, the ECHO ISA Performance handicap system and the ISA safety Regulations for day racing.

2.1 All boats shall submit valid IRC and ECHO certificates on or before 13.00 on the 6th of Aug 2010'.

Echo handicaps will be brought forward from last Super League event ie WIORA etc.

2.2 ECHO handicaps may be revised during the regatta.

The act of handicap adjustment or failure to adjust will not be grounds for redress.

3 THE RACES

There will be six races in total, 2 races each day,

including round the cans and laid windward /leeward courses.

It is the intension to hold one coastal race.
